AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF APPLETON, WISCONSIN.

(MEMORIAL FLORIST Annexation)

The Common Council of the City of Appleton does ordain as follows:

Section 1. <u>Territory Annexed</u>. In accordance with Sec. 66.0217 of the Wisconsin Statutes for 1999-2000 and the <u>Unanimous Petition for Direct Annexation</u> filed with the City Clerk on May 16, 2001, the following described territory in the Town of Menasha, Winnebago County, Wisconsin, lying contiguous to the City of Appleton, is hereby annexed to the City of Appleton, Wisconsin:

Being the East 307 feet of Lot Fourteen (14), Block Five (5), in LYNCH PLAT, located in the NW ¼ of the NW ¼, Section 1, Township 20 North, Range 17 East, Town of Menasha, Winnebago County, Wisconsin;

AND

Also a portion of Gardner's Row right of way in the Lynch Plat, also being part of the NW 1/4 of Section 1, T.20N., R.17E., Town of Menasha, Winnebago County, Wisconsin and being described by:

Commencing at the NW corner of Lot 14 in said Lynch Plat;

Thence Easterly 585', along the North line of said Lot 14, also being the South line of Gardner's Row, to the point of beginning;

Thence continue Easterly along the extended North line of said Lot 14 to a point on the Northwesterly line of Lot 15 of said Lynch Plat, also being the Easterly line of a North and South running portion of Gardner's Row;

Thence Southwesterly along the arc of a curve to the left having a 60' tangent and a central angle of 55°55', along the Northwesterly line of Lots 15 and then Lot 16 of said Lynch Plat, also being the Easterly line of said Gardner's Row;

Thence Southerly along the Westerly line of Lot 16 of said Lynch Plat, also being the Easterly line of said Gardner's Row, to the Easterly extension of the South line of Lot 14 of said Lynch Plat;

Thence Westerly along the extended South line of Lot 14 of said Lynch Plat, to the West line of said Gardner's Row and also being the Southeast corner of said Lot 14;

Thence Northerly 136.85' m/l along the West line of said Gardner's Row and also being

the Easterly line of said Lot 14;

Thence Northwesterly 78.54' along the arc of a curve to the left having a 50' radius and a central angle of 90° along a Northeasterly part of said Lot 14, also being the Westerly and then Southerly line of said Gardner's Row to the point of beginning.

The current population of such territory is 0 people.

Section 2. <u>Effect of Annexation</u>. From and after the date of this Ordinance, the territory described in Section 1 shall be a part of the City of Appleton for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the City of Appleton.

Section 3. Ward Designation. The territory described in Sec. 1 of this Ordinance is hereby made a part of the Fifty-fourth (54th) Ward, attached to the Eighth (8th) Aldermanic District of the City of Appleton, Winnebago County, subject to the ordinances, rules and regulations of the City governing Wards.

Section 4. Zoning Classification. The territory described in Sec. 1 is hereby zoned as follows, pursuant to Sec. 66.0217(7)(a), *Stats*. and Sec. 23.65(e), *Appleton Municipal Code*:

Temporary PD/C-2 (Temporary Planned Development/General Commercial District)

Section 5. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this Ordinance to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance, which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication.
