ANNEXING ORDINANCE 51302-1 VB
AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE VILLAGE OF ROBERTS, WISCONSIN

The Village Board of the Village of Roberts, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Territory Annexed. In accordance with sec. 66.021 of the Wisconsin Statutes and the petition for direct annexation filed with the village clerk on 17th day of January, 2002; signed by all the owners of the real property located in the territory, there being no electors therein, the following described territory in the Town of Warren, St. Croix County, Wisconsin, is annexed to the Village of Roberts, Wisconsin:

A part of the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 and the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4, Section 15, T29N, R18W, Town of Warren, St. Croix County Wisconsin, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the South Quarter Corner said Section 15, Thence S89°46'37"W along the south line of said Section 15 579.85 feet;

Thence S01°02'16"W 975.00 Feet;

Thence N89°46'37"E 579.98 Feet;

Thence N89°02'49"E 500.07 Feet;

Thence S01°02'16"E 975.00 Feet to the south line of said section 15;

Thence 89°02'49"W along said south line of Section 15 500.21 Feet


To the point of beginning;


Said parcel contains 24.17 acres more or less and is subject to the right-of-way of U.S.H. 12/S.T.H. 65 over the south 33.00 feet of said parcel.

SECTION 2. Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of this ordinance the territory described in section 1 shall be a part of the Village of Roberts for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the Village of Roberts.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

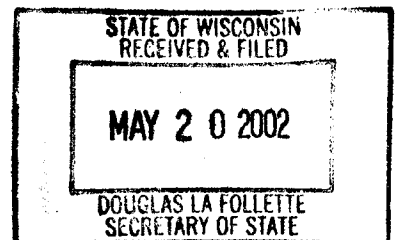
SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.

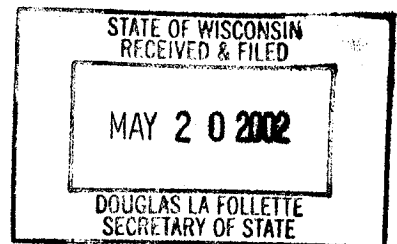


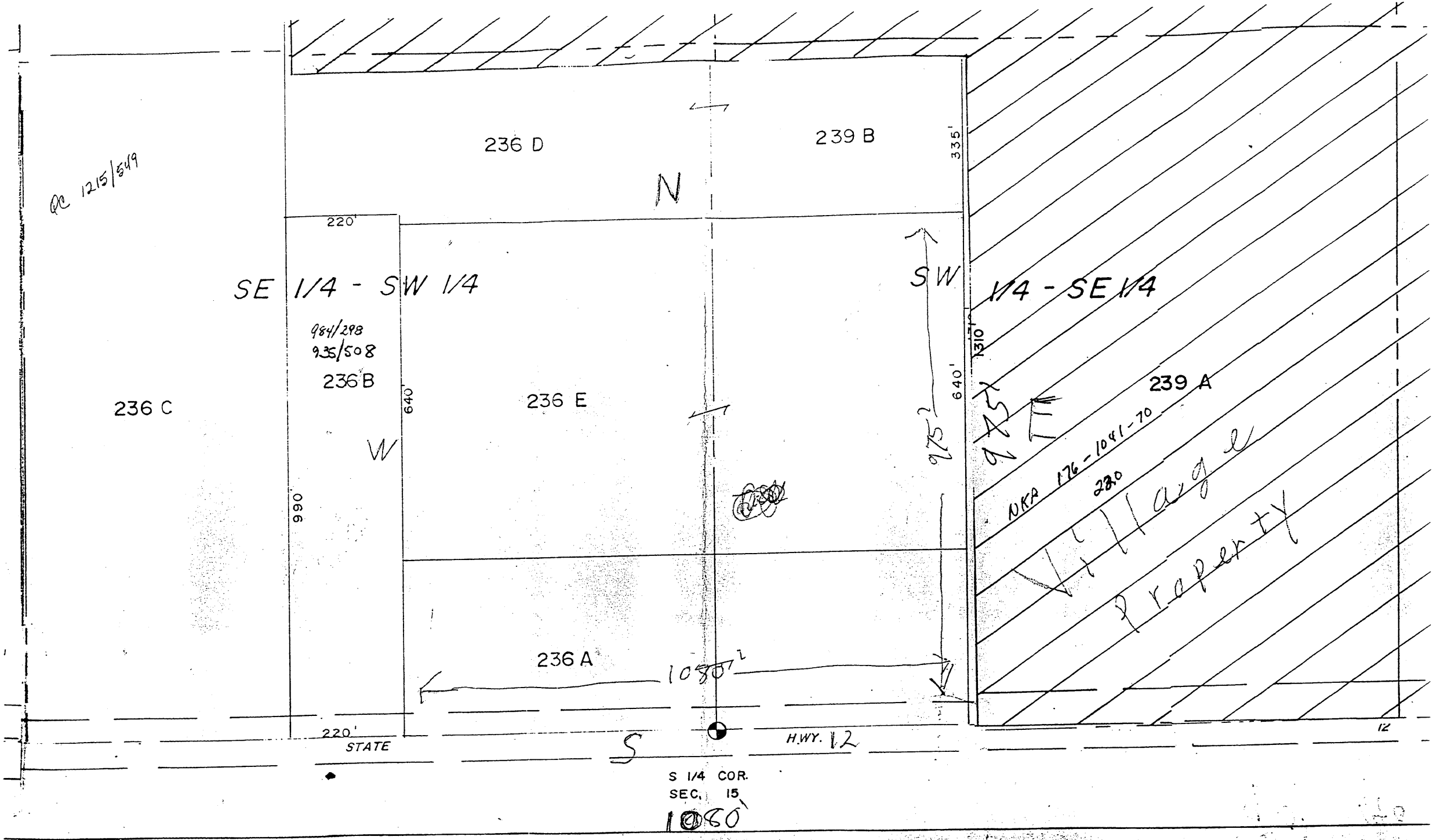
