# ORDINANCE NO. 9-2002

### **VILLAGE OF CROSS PLAINS**


AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE DIRECT ANNEXATION OF A PORTION OF THE TOWN OF CROSS PLAINS, DANE COUNTY, WISCONSIN, TO THE VILLAGE OF CROSS PLAINS, DANE COUNTY, WISCONSIN

#### **RECITALS**

A. On October 7, 2002, a petition to annex the following described land (the "Territory") to the Village of Cross Plains was filed with the Village Clerk of the Village of Cross Plains:

A parcel of land located in the northeast 1/4 of the northeast 1/4 of Section 9, T7N, R7E, Town of Cross Plains, Dane County, Wisconsin, To-wit: Commencing at the north 1/4 corner of said Section 9; thence S88°26'30"E, along the north line of the northeast 1/4 of said Section 9, 1, 292.07 feet to the southwest corner of Cedar Hill and point of beginning; thence continuing S88°26'30"E, along said north line of the NE 1/4 and the south line of said Cedar Hill, 586.00 feet; thence S01°33'30"W, 100.00 feet; thence S23°13'05"E, 240.00 feet; thence S63°44'52"W, 247.93 feet; thence S61°01'45"W, 520.85 feet; thence N00°01'45"E, 698.41 feet to the point of beginning. Containing 7.39 acres.

- B. The petition was signed by all qualified electors residing in the Territory and the owners of all the real property in the Territory, in accordance with sec. 66.0217(2), Wis. Stats.
- C. A copy of the petition, together with a scale map and a legal description of the Territory, has been filed with the Wisconsin Department of Administration and the Clerk of the Town of Cross Plains.
- D. More than 20 days have passed since the Department of Administration received a copy of the annexation petition, and the Village has considered the advice received from the Department, if any.



Now, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Cross Plains, Dane County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

#### **ORDINANCE**

- 1. <u>Territory Annexed</u>. In accordance with sec. 66.0217, Wis. Stats., the Village Board hereby annexes the above described Territory to the Village of Cross Plains.
- 2. <u>Scale Map</u>. The scale map, attached as Exhibit A, shows the Territory to be annexed and its relationship to the boundaries of the Village of Cross Plains and the Town of Cross Plains.
- 3. <u>Effect of Annexation</u>. From and after the effective date of this ordinance, the Territory shall be a part of the Village of Cross Plains for any and all purposes provided by law, and all persons coming or residing within such Territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules, and regulations governing the Village of Cross Plains.
- 4. <u>Temporary Zoning Classification</u>. Upon recommendation of the Plan Commission, the Territory is temporarily designated to be part of the R-1 Single Family Residential District of the Village for zoning purposes and subject to all provisions of the zoning ordinance of the Village relating to such district classification. The Plan Commission is directed to prepare an ordinance providing for the permanent zoning classification for the Territory and to submit its recommendations to the Village Board, with the temporary zoning classification to continue until adoption of a permanent zoning classification.
- 5. <u>Ward Designation</u>. The Territory annexed by this ordinance is added to the <u>/s+</u> ward of the Village.
- 6. <u>Clerk Duties</u>. The Village Clerk is hereby directed, pursuant to the provisions of sec. 66.0217(9)(a), Wis. Stats., to immediately file and record as appropriate, certain documents (a certified copy of this ordinance, a certificate of population, a legal description of the Territory, a scale map) with the following: the Wisconsin Secretary of State; each company that provides any utility service in the Territory; the Register of Deeds; the clerk of any affected school district; and the Town Clerk of the Town of Cross Plains.
- 7. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage and posting pursuant to law.

8. <u>Severability</u>. If any provision in this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

The above ordinance was duly adopted by a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of the elected members of the Village Board for the Village of Cross Plains at a <u>Certifical</u> meeting held on <u>11 11 02</u>, 2002.
