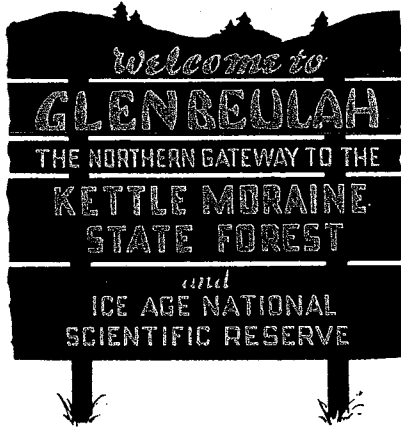

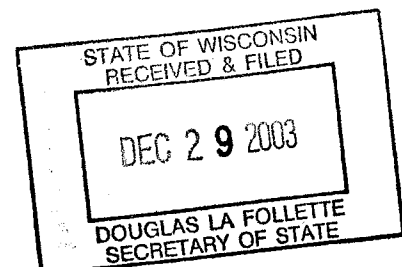

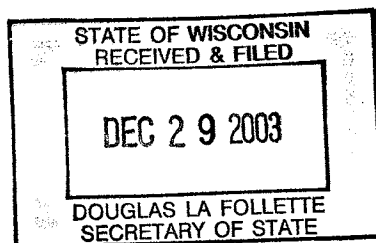

ORDINANCE NO. 4 OF 2003

RE: An Ordinance Detaching Certain Lands from the Town of Greenbush and Attaching the Same to the Village of Glenbeulah, Sheboygan County, Wisconsin

THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF GLENBEULAH, SHEBOYGAN COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: After due notice to all interested parties and there being no objections from the State of Wisconsin, the following described lands are hereby detached from the Town of Greenbush and attached to the Village of Glenbeulah, Sheboygan County, Wisconsin:

Town of Greenbush Tax Parcel No. 59002000360

Part of the SW1/4 of the SE1/4, Section 1, T15N, R20E, Town of Greenbush, Sheboygan County, Wisconsin, commencing 412.5 feet South of the Northeast corner of said quarter, thence West along the South corporate line of the Village of Glenbeulah 412.5 feet, thence South 247.5 feet, more or less, to the South line of the N1/2 of the SW1/4 of the SE1/4, thence East 412.5 feet, thence North 247.5 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.

Town of Greenbush Tax Parcel No. 59002000400

Part of the SE1/4 of the SE1/4, Section 1, T15N, R20E, Town of Greenbush, Sheboygan County, Wisconsin, commencing at the Northwest corner of said quarter, thence South 712 feet, thence East 128 feet, thence North 422 feet, thence West 40 feet, thence North 290 feet, thence West 88 feet to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2: The above described lands are hereby zoned Agricultural.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, publication and recording as provided by law.

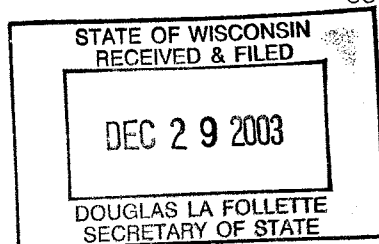
