## ORDINANCE FOR ANNEXATION OF BRUNNER PROPERTY INTO THE CITY OF MAUSTON

WHEREAS, a Petition for Annexation, dated 8/30/02, has been filed with the City Clerk by Circulator Ronald E. Brunner; and

WHEREAS, the Petition has been duly and properly circulated by the Circulator, and has been duly and properly signed by all of the electors residing in the territory to be annexed and signed by all of the owners of land in such territory; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Petition was accepted and approved by the Common Council on September 10, 2002;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** the Common Council for the City of Mauston does hereby ordain as follows:




