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ORDINANCE 2004-01

The Village Board of Village of Big Bend, Wisconsin do ordain as follows: <u>SECTION 1.</u> Territory Annexed. In accordance with Sec. 66.0217 of the Wisconsin Statutes and the petition for direct annexation filed with the Village Clerk on the 26th day of November, 2003, signed by all electors residing in the territory and the owners of all the land in the territory, the following described territory in the Town of Vernon, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, is annexed to the Village of Big Bend, Wisconsin:

Lands described in Exhibit A attached hereto.

The population of the annexed territory is zero (0).

<u>SECTION 2.</u> Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of this ordinance the territory described in Section 1 shall be part of the Village of Big Bend for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the Village of Big Bend.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. Temporary Zoning Classification. (a) Upon recommendation of the Plan Commission, the territory annexed to the Village of Big Bend by this ordinance is temporarily zoned as follows, pursuant to Sec. 66.0217(8)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes:

R-2 Country Home District

(b) The Plan Commission is directed to prepare an amendment to the zoning ordinace setting forth permanent classifications and regulations for the zoning of the annexed area and to submit its recommendations to the board not later than 90 days following adoption of the ordinance.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. Ward designation. The territory described in Section 1 of this ordinance is hereby made a part of Ward 3 of the Village of Big Bend, subject to the ordinances, rules and regulations of the Village governing wards.

<u>SECTION 5.</u> Severability. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

SECTION 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
