ORDINANCE NO. A-540

The City of Wisconsin Dells, Columbia, Sauk, and Adams Counties, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION I: PURPOSE

The zoning map as set forth in section 19.03(2) of the City of Wisconsin Dells Code is hereby permanently amended to include the property set forth below as petitioned for Direct Annexation by Unanimous Consent of property owners Robert E. Francis and Patricia P. Francis.

SECTION II: PROVISION AMENDED

Wisconsin Dells Code sec. 19.03(2) is amended.

SECTION III: PROPERTY ANNEXED

Pursuant to Wis. Stat. sec. 66.0217, the following described property is hereby annexed to the City of Wisconsin Dells from the Town of Delton, Sauk County, Wisconsin and the Town of Lyndon, Juneau County, Wisconsin. Population of said territory is zero (0):

A parcel of land located in the Northeast and Southeast Quarters of the Southeast Quarter of Section 32, and the Southeast and Southwest Quarters of the Southwest Quarter of Section 33, Township 14 North, Range 6 East, Town of Lyndon, Juneau County, Wisconsin, and in the Northeast, Northwest, Southeast, and Southwest Quarters of the Northwest Quarter of Section 4, and the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 5, Township 13 North, Range 6 East, Town of Delton, Sauk County, Wisconsin.

SECTION IV: VALIDITY

Should any section, clause or provision of the ordinance be declared by the courts to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.

SECTION V: CONFLICTING PROVISIONS REPEALED

All ordinances in conflict with any provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION VI: EFFECTIVE DATE

The provisions of this ordinance shall be in force from and after their introduction and publication as provided by statute.

SECTION VII:

This ordinance becomes a part of the Zoning Map for the City of Wisconsin Dells.
