



ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF EAU CLAIRE

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EAU CLAIRE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Territory Annexed</u>. In accordance with Section 66.0217 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the following described territory in the Town of Washington, Eau Claire County, Wisconsin, is annexed to the city of Eau Claire, Wisconsin.

Lots 1 and 2 of Block 1 of J. H. McElroy's Addition and South Valley View Place right-of-way, all in the SE 1/4 - NW 1/4 of Section 34, T 27 N, R 9 W, Town of Washington, Eau Claire County, Wisconsin, all described as follows:

Commencing at the north quarter corner of said Section 34; thence S. 00°25'21" E. along the east line of the NW 1/4 of said Section 34 2105.03 feet; thence N. 89°46'15" W. 144.41 feet to the NE corner of Lot 1 of Block 1 of J. H. McElroy's Addition and point of beginning; thence N. 90°46'15" W. along the north line of Lots 1 and 2 of Block 1 and their westerly extension 392.47 feet to the westerly R/W line of South Valley View Place and easterly R/W line of S.T.H. 93; thence S. 04°22'04" E. along the westerly R/W line of South Valley View Place 70.73 feet to the westerly extension of the south line of Lots 1 and 2 of Block 1 of J. H. McElroy's Addition; thence S. 89°46'15" E. along the south line of said Lots 1 and 2 of Block 1 of J. H. McElroy's Addition and their westerly extension 386.80 feet to the SE corner of said Lot 1; thence N. 00°13'45" W. along the east line of said Lot 1 Block 1 70.5 feet to the point of beginning.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Effect of Annexation.</u> From and after the date of this ordinance, the territory described in Section 1 shall be part of the city of Eau Claire for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the city of Eau Claire.

Section 3. <u>Temporary Zoning Classification</u>. The territory annexed to the city of Eau Claire by this ordinance is temporarily designated to be R-1A -- Non-Sewered One-Family Dwelling District for zoning purposes and subject to all provisions of the zoning ordinance of the city of Eau Claire relating to such district classification and to zoning in the city.

Section 4. Ward Designation. The territory described in Section 1 of this ordinance is hereby made a part of the 15th Assessment Ward and the 2nd Aldermanic District of the city of Eau Claire, subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations of the city governing wards and districts.

Section 5. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or application of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or applications.
