

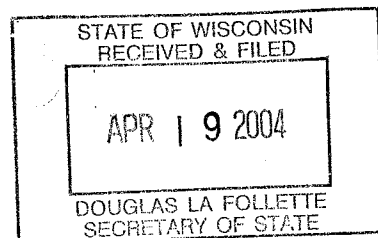

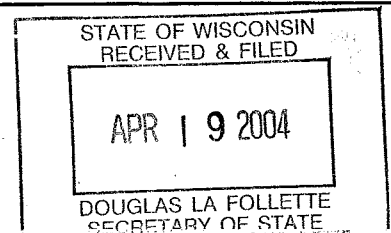

AN ORDINANCE

The Common Council of the City of Merrill, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Territory Annexed. The following described parcels from the Town of Pine River, Lincoln County, Wisconsin are annexed to the City of Merrill, Wisconsin:

Southwest Quarter (SW ¼) of the Northeast Quarter (NE ¼), Section Seven (7), Township Thirty-one (31) North, Range Seven (7) East, and the Southeast Quarter (SE ¼) of the Northeast Quarter (NE ¼), Section Seven (7), Township Thirty-one (31) North, Range Seven (7) East, Town of Pine River, Lincoln County, Wisconsin.

Section 2. Condition and Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of publication of this ordinance, the territory described in Section 1 above shall be part of the City of Merrill for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to the ordinances, rules and regulations of the City governing wards.

Section 3. Aldermanic Designation. The territory described in Section 1 of this ordinance is hereby made a part of the First Aldermanic District of the City of Merrill subject to the ordinances, rules and regulations of the City governing wards.

Section 4. Schools. The territory described in Section 1 is annexed for school purposes to the Merrill Area Common Public School District and subject to all laws governing the same.


Section 5. Zoning. The territory described in Section 1 is hereby temporarily zoned Rural Development.

Section 6. Severability. In the event any section, subsection, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance. It is the legislative intent of the Common Council that this ordinance would have been adopted if such illegal provision had not been included or any illegal application had not been made.


Section 7. Repeal and Effective Date. All ordinances or parts of ordinances and resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.

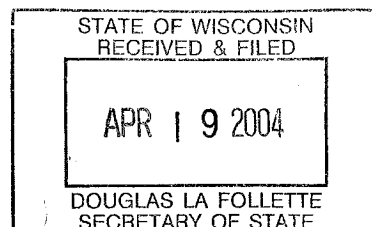

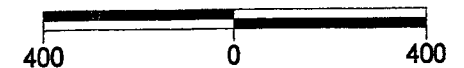


BEING THE SW 1/4 OF THE NE 1/4 AND THE SE 1/4 OF THE NE 1/4

BEARINGS ARE REFERENCED TO THE LINCOLN COUNTY COORDINATE SYSTEM.

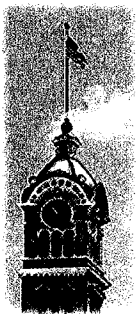
