ORDINANCE NUMBER ORD: 040706-C#398

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF OMRO

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OMRO, WINNEBAGO COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DO HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, Harlan and Cecilia Davidson, are the sole owners of the following described real estate:

Parcel 016-0427-02, S16/T18/R15 in the Town of Omro, Winnebago County, Wisconsin, described as PT NE NW DESC AS LOT 1 of CSM 4694, being a parcel of land of 0.47 acres.

WHEREAS, pursuant to §66.013(2)(b) of the Wis. Stats., the current population, and qualified electors, residing on said property, is two (2); and

WHEREAS, the petitioner has filed the petition with the City Clerk and the Town Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the petitioner has mailed a copy of the petition with a scale map and legal description to the Department of Administration; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council has reviewed the advice of the Department; and

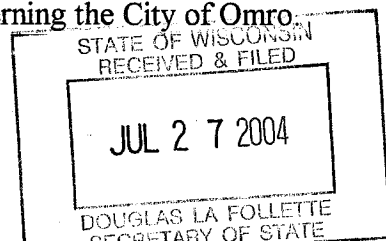
WHEREAS, such lands are contiguous to other lands within the Fourth Ward of the Second Aldermanic District of the City of Omro and; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Omro deems it to be in the best interest of the City if the above described contiguous territory located in the Town of Omro be detached from the Town of Omro and annexed to the City of Omro, specifically to the Fourth Ward thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Omro, Winnebago County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Territory Annexed. In accordance with section 66.0217 of the Wisconsin Statutes, and the unanimous petition for direct annexation, the property described above is annexed to the City of Omro.

Section 2. Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of this ordinance the territory described in section 1 shall be a part of the City of Omro for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the City of Omro.



Section 3. Zoning. The Plan Commission is directed to prepare an amendment to the zoning ordinance setting forth permanent classifications and regulations to the Council.

Section 4. Ward Designation. The territory described in section 1 of this ordinance is hereby made a part of the fourth ward of the City of Omro, subject to ordinances, rules and regulations of the city governing wards.

Section 5. Schools. The territory described in section 1 is annexed for school purposes and is hereby made a part of the city school district and subject to all laws governing the same.

Section 6. Notifications. That the proper City Officials are hereby authorized and directed to comply with the notice and filing requirements of Wisconsin State Statutes pertaining to this annexation.

Section 7. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid unconstitutional provision or application.

Section 8. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
