## ORDINANCE NO. A-565 (Parkerst & Trappers Turn Annexation)

The City of Wisconsin Dells, Columbia, Sauk, Juneau and Adams Counties, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

#### **SECTION I: PURPOSE**

The zoning map as set forth in section 19.03(2) of the City of Wisconsin Dells Code is hereby permanently amended to include the property set forth below as petitioned for Direct Annexation by Unanimous Consent of property owners Parkerst, LLC and Trappers Turn Inc.

#### **SECTION II: PROVISION AMENDED**

Wisconsin Dells Code sec. 19.03(2) is amended.

#### **SECTION III: PROPERTY ANNEXED**

Pursuant to Wis. Stat. sec. 66.0217, the following described property is hereby annexed to the City of Wisconsin Dells from the Town of Delton, Sauk County, Wisconsin. Said parcel contains 69 acres, more or less, and has a said population of seven (7):

A parcel of land located in the Fractional NW ¼ - NW ¼ , SE ¼ - NW ¼ and the SW ¼ - NW ¼, Section 4, and the Fractional NE ¼ - NE ¼ and Fractional NW ¼ - NE ¼, Section 5, all in the T13N, R6E, Town of Delton, Sauk County, Wisconsin. (Complete legal description is attached as Exhibit "A")

#### SECTION IV: VALIDITY

Should any section, clause or provision of the ordinance be declared by the courts to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.

#### SECTION V: CONFLICTING PROVISIONS REPEALED

All ordinances in conflict with any provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

### SECTION VI: EFFECTIVE DATE

The provisions of this ordinance shall be in force from and after their introduction and publication as provided by statute.



Subject: PARKERST & TRAPPERS TURN ANNEXATION

The proposed annexation submitted to our office on September 1, 2004, has been reviewed and found to be in the public interest.

The subject petition is for territory that is reasonably shaped and contiguous to the City of Wisconsin Dells. However, a portion of the territory proposed for annexation extends into the right-of-way of US Highway 12 and 16, where adjoining right-of-way remains with the Town, thereby introducing prospective public safety/emergency medical assistance and other issues. For purposes of uniform law enforcement and reducing confusion for public safety personnel, we would recommend omitting this "wedge" from the annexation petition. (Actually having an underlying property easement within a federal highway right-of-way would be unusual. Is this a mistake?)

The Department reminds clerks of annexing municipalities of the requirements of s. 66.0217 (9)(a), Wis. Stats., which states:

"The clerk of a city or village which has annexed shall file immediately with the secretary of state a certified copy of the ordinance, certificate and plat, and shall send one copy to each company that provides any utility service in the area that is annexed. The clerk shall record the ordinance with the register of deeds and file a signed copy of the ordinance with the clerk of any affected school district..."

State and federal aids based on population and equalized value may be significantly affected through failure to file with the Secretary of State. Please file a copy of your annexing ordinance, including a statement certifying the population of the annexed territory. The address of the Office of the Secretary of State is:
