AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORIES TO THE CITY OF PORT WASHINGTON, WISCONSIN

The Common Council of the City of Port Washington, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Territories Annexed. In accordance with sec. 66.0217 of the Wisconsin Statutes and the Petition for Direct Annexations filed with the City Clerk on the 6th day of June, 2005, signed by owners of all of the land in area and all of the electors in the territories, the following described territories in the Town of Port Washington, Ozaukee County, Wisconsin, are annexed to the City of Port Washington, Wisconsin:

See legal descriptions attached hereto as Exhibit A

SECTION 2. Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of this ordinance the territories described in Section 1 shall be a part of the City of Port Washington for any and all purposes provided by law, and all persons coming or residing within such territories shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the City of Port Washington.

- **SECTION 3. Temporary Zoning Classification.** (a) Upon recommendation of the Plan Commission, the territories annexed to the City of Port Washington by this ordinance are temporarily zoned as follows, pursuant to sec. 66.0217 (8) of the Wisconsin Statutes: AG Agricultural District
- (b) As soon as practicable following annexation of the territories described in Section 1, the Plan Commission shall prepare an amendment to the zoning ordinance setting forth permanent classifications and regulations for the zoning of the annexed area and submit its recommendations to the Common Council.
- **SECTION 4.** Ward and Aldermanic District Designation. The territories described in Section 1 of this ordinance are hereby made a part of the 4th ward and 4th aldermanic district of the City of Port Washington, subject to the ordinances, rules and regulations of the City of Port Washington governing wards.

SECTION 5. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, of if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

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
