HESSE, the duly elected and qualified City Clerk of the City of Appleton, County of Outagamie, State of Wisconsin, DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the following described territory was detached from the Town of Buchanan and was annexed to said City of Appleton pursuant to 66.0217 of the Wisconsin Statutes of 2001-2003, by an Ordinance adopted by the Common Council at a regular meeting held October 19, 2005.



AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF APPLETON, WISCONSIN.

(Bahr Annexation)

The Common Council of the City of Appleton does ordain as follows:

Section 1. *Territory Annexed.* In accordance with Sec. 66.0217 of the *Wisconsin Statutes* for 2003-2004 and the *Unanimous Petition for Direct Annexation* filed with the City Clerk on August 12, 2005, the following described territory in the Town of Buchanan, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, lying contiguous to the City of Appleton, is hereby annexed to the City of Appleton, Wisconsin:

Being a parcel of land in Government Lot Two (2), Section 29, Township 21 North, Range 18 East, Town of Buchanan, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the West line of said Government Lot 2, with the centerline of Newberry Street (formerly known as Kimberly Avenue) as the point of beginning; thence Northeasterly along the centerline of Newberry Street, 131 feet; thence South parallel with the West line of Government Lot 2, 195 feet; thence Southwesterly, parallel with the centerline of Newberry Street, 131 feet to the West line of Government Lot 2; thence North along the West line of Government Lot 2, 195 feet to the point of beginning.

The current population of such territory is 3 people.

Section 2. <u>Effect of Annexation</u>. From and after the date of this Ordinance, the territory described in Section 1 shall be a part of the City of Appleton for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the City of Appleton.

Section 3. Ward Designation. The territory described in Section 1 of this Ordinance is hereby made a part of the Fifty-eighth (58th) Ward, attached to the Third (3rd) Aldermanic District of the City of Appleton, Outagamie County, subject to the ordinances, rules and regulations of the City governing Wards.

Section 4. Zoning Classification. The territory described in Section 1 is hereby zoned as

follows, pursuant to Sec. 66.0217(7)(a), Stats. and Sec. 23-37(b), Appleton Municipal Code:

R-1A (Single-Family District)

Section 5. <u>Severability</u>. If any provision of this Ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance, which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication.
