

# AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF CUMBERLAND, WISCONSIN

The Common Council of the City of Cumberland do ordain as follows:

SECTION ONE. Territory Annexed. In accordance with sec. 66.0217 of the Wisconsin Statutes, and the petition for direct annexation filed with the City Clerk-Treasurer on July 11, 2005, signed by all of the electors and by the owners of all of the land in area in the territory, the following described territory in the Town of Cumberland, Barron County, Wisconsin, is annexed to the City of Cumberland, Wisconsin:

A parcel of land located in Government Lot No. 4, Section 8, Township 35 North, Range 13 West, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Quarter Corner between Sections 7 and 8, Township 35 North, Range 13 West, thence N 89° 31' E along the Quarter Line 1015.5 feet, thence N 0° 11' W 50 feet to the North Line of S. T. Highway No. 48 to an iron pipe designating the place of beginning, thence continuing N 0° 11' W 210 feet, thence N 89° 31' E 150 feet, thence S 0° 11' E 210 feet to the North line of said highway, thence S 89° 31' W along the North line of said highway 150 feet to the point of beginning.

<u>SECTION TWO</u>. Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of this Ordinance, the territory described in Section One shall be a part of the City of Cumberland for any and all purposes provided by law, and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules, and regulations governing the City of Cumberland.

<u>SECTION THREE</u>. Ward Designation. The territory described in Section One of this Ordinance is hereby made a part of the Third Ward of the City of Cumberland, subject to the ordinances, rules, and regulations of the City governing wards.

<u>SECTION FOUR</u>. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this Ordinance to any persons or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

<u>SECTION FIVE</u>. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect on the day after passage and publication as provided by law.
