<u>Section 1</u>. <u>Territory Annexed</u>. In accordance with Chapter 66, Wisconsin Statutes, and the petition for direct annexation submitted by WM Development LLC, sole owner of the land now located in the Town of Wausau, Marathon County, Wisconsin, and being a part of the D.C. Everest Area School District, there being no electors residing therein, the following described land is hereby annexed to the City of Wausau:

Part of the SW¼ of the SE¼ and part of the SE¼ of the SE¼ and part of the NE¼ of the SE¼, all in Section 31, Township 29 North, Range 8 East, Town of Wausau, Marathon County, Wisconsin, described as follows:

Lot 1 of Certified Survey Map No. 14151 recorded in the office of Register of Deeds for Marathon County in Volume 62 of Certified Survey Maps on page 158.

If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance, which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

Section 9. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
