AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE THE ATTACHMENT OF PROPERTY TO THE VILLAGE OF MUKWONAGO FROM THE TOWN OF MUKWONAGO PURSUANT TO THE MUNICIPAL BOUNDARY AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWN OF MUKWONAGO

WHEREAS, the Village of Mukwonago and the Town of Mukwonago entered into a Municipal Boundary Agreement on or about April 28, 2000, pursuant to Section 66.027, Wisconsin Statutes, which was incorporated into the judgment of the Waukesha County Circuit Court in Case No. 99-CV-2565 on or about July 5, 2000, and more than 30 days passed since the publication of the stipulation and no referendum has been filed to contest the matter, and therefore the Municipal Boundary Agreement is in effect and is binding upon the Village of Mukwonago and the Town of Mukwonago, and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Boundary Agreement provided in Section 2 a process by which property owners with property located within the areas described in Section 2 of the Municipal Boundary Agreement may detach their property from the Town of Mukwonago and attach to the Village of Mukwonago; and
