

The population of the annexed parcels is zero.

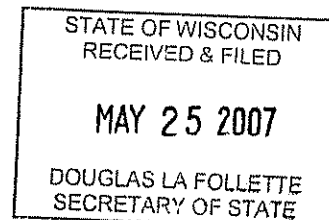

Ordinance 2007-1-

An ordinance to approve an Annexation

Whereas a Petition for direct annexation by unanimous approval of the following territories in the Town of Lowville, Columbia County, Wisconsin, to the Village of Rio, Wisconsin was filed with the Village clerk on March 23, 2007:

Parcel 1 - Town of Lowville parcel (No. 26.A) owned by Christa M. Johnson.

The parcel is located in Section 1, T11N, R10E, of the Town of Lowville, Columbia County, Wisconsin, is part of the SE1/4 of the SE 1/4 lying north of Lowville road and east of State Highway 16, and is south of and contiguous to Village of Rio parcel 342, and east of and contiguous to Village of Rio parcel 341, and shall include the Lowville road right-of-way immediately abutting and contiguous to said property. This territory contains one-tenth of an acre more or less.

Parcel 2 - Town of Lowville parcel (No. 29) owned by Viking LLC.


The parcel is located in Section 1, T11N, R10E, of the Town of Lowville, Columbia County, Wisconsin, is part of the SE1/4 of the SE 1/4 lying north and east of State Highway 16 and south of Lowville Road, and is contiguous to Village of Rio parcel 326 which is also owned by Viking LLC, and shall include the Lowville road right-of-way immediately abutting and contiguous to said property. This territory contains 3.0 acres more or less.

And Whereas the Wisconsin Department of Administration has investigated said Petition and advised the Village Board that the territories to be annexed, described in the Petition and shown on the scale map attached thereto, are contiguous to the Village of Rio and are unincorporated; and that the annexation is in the public interest, *and*

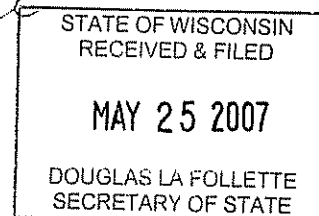
Whereas the Plan Commission of the Village of Rio has reviewed and approved the petition;

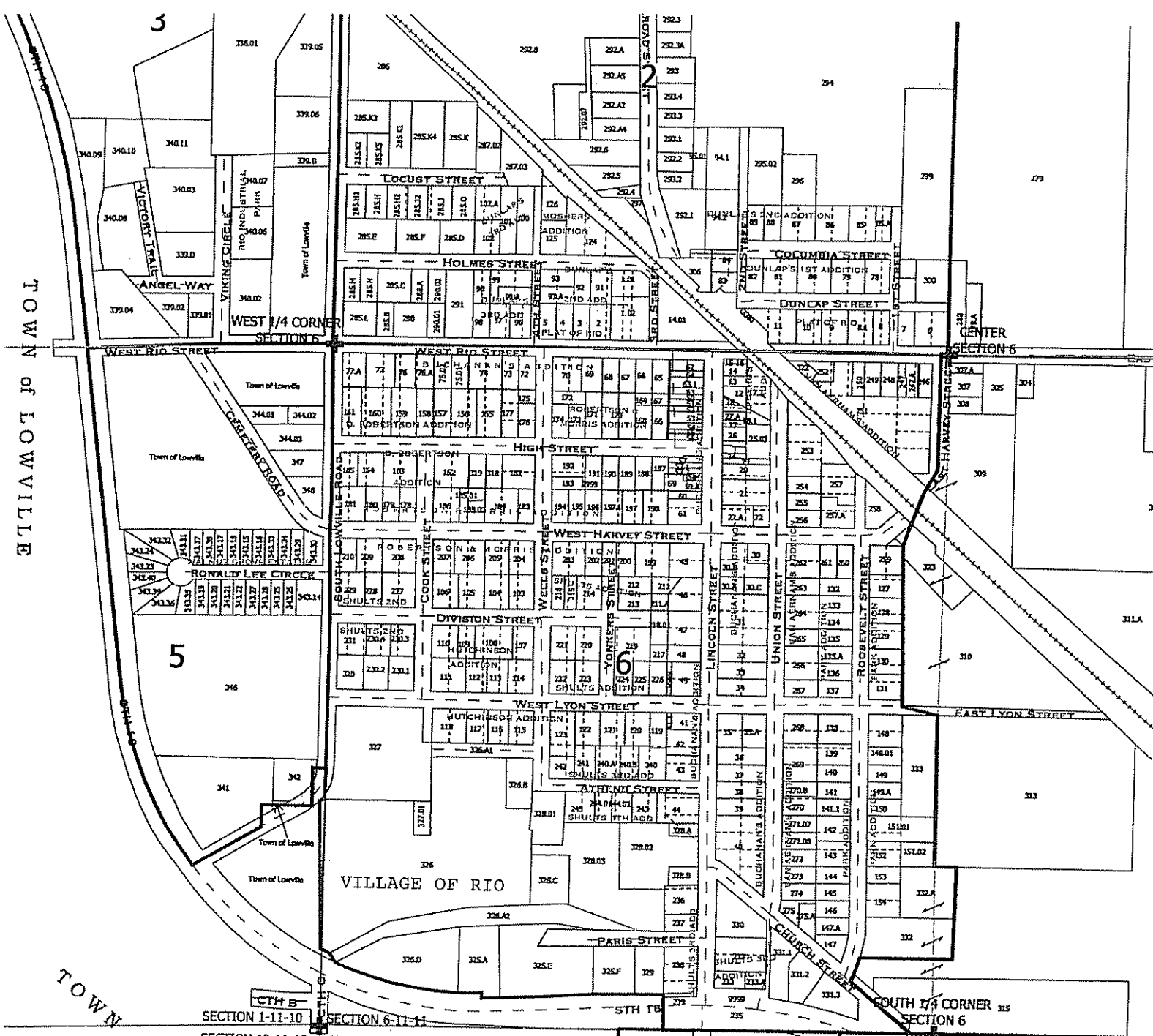

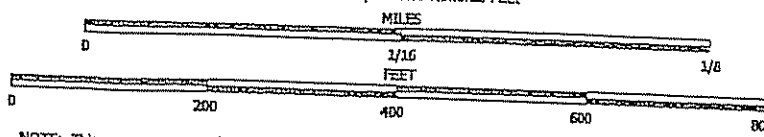
