

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 3
AMENDING CHAPTERS 1 AND 5
REGARDING THE APPOINTMENT OF VARIOUS VILLAGE OFFICIALS

WHEREAS, Section 1.02 of the Village of West Baraboo Municipal Code (“Code”) establishes the process of and term of an appointment for various Village officials;

WHEREAS, Sections 5.01, 5.02, and 5.05 of the Code establish the process of and term of an appointment with respect to Village fire protection services;

WHEREAS, the Village wishes to update Sections 1.02, 5.01, 5.02 and 5.05 of the Code;

WHEREAS, the Village Board finds that the amendments are in the best interest of the Village;

WHEREAS, the Village of West Baraboo, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 66.0101 and Wis. Stat. § 61.195, hereby elects not to be governed by any portion of Wis. Stats. Ch. 61 (including Wis. Stat. § 61.19) that conflicts with the amendments set forth below;

THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of West Baraboo, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

1. Section 1.02 of the Code is amended as follows:¹

(1) VILLAGE CLERK-TREASURER (Ch. Ord. #1). The Village Clerk-Treasurer shall be appointed by a majority vote of the members-elect of the Village Board for an indefinite term subject to removal by the Village Board pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 17.13(1)~~for a term of 2 years commencing on May 1 following his appointment.~~

(2) VILLAGE ATTORNEY. The Village Attorney shall be appointed annually by the Village President, subject to confirmation by the Village Board, for a two-year~~one year~~ term commencing on May 1.

(3) VILLAGE ASSESSOR (Ch. Ord. #2). The Village Assessor shall be appointed by a majority vote of the members-elect of the Village Board for a two-year~~term of 2 years~~ term commencing on May 1 following his appointment.

(4) DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS. The Director of Public Works shall be appointed by the Village President, subject to confirmation by the Village Board, for an indefinite term subject to removal by the Village Board pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 17.13(1).

(5) BUILDING INSPECTOR. The Building Inspector shall be appointed by the Village President subject to confirmation by the Village Board for an indefinite term, subject to removal by the Village Board pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 17.13(1).

(6) PLUMBING INSPECTOR. The Plumbing Inspector shall be appointed by the Village President, subject to confirmation by the Village Board, for an indefinite term, subject to removal by the Village Board pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 17.13(1).

(7) ELECTRICAL INSPECTOR. The Electrical Inspector shall be appointed by the Village President, subject to confirmation by the Village Board, for an indefinite term, subject to removal by the Village Board pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 17.13(1).

(8) FIRE INSPECTOR. See sec. 5.05 of this Code.

(9) EMERGENCY GOVERNMENT. The Village President shall act as the head of emergency management services. The Director of Public Works is designated as the deputy head of emergency management services and, in the absence of Village President or at his or her directions, shall perform the same duties and have the same powers as head of emergency management services. ~~Emergency Government Director. In the absence of the Village President, the Director of Public Works shall act in that capacity.~~

(10) WEED COMMISSIONER. The Weed Commissioner shall be appointed by the Village President in May of each year for a term of one year.

2. Section 5.01, 5.02, and 5.05 of the Code is amended as follows:

5.01 FIRE PROTECTION AGREEMENT. Fire protection is provided by the City of Baraboo ~~Volunteer Rural~~ Fire Department, pursuant to an agreement between the Village and the City of Baraboo.

5.02 FIRE CHIEF, POWERS AND DUTIES. The Fire chief of the City of Baraboo ~~Rural-Volunteer~~ Fire Department shall direct the operation of the Department at fires within the Village, subject to Department rules and regulations and Village ordinances, issue and enforce such orders as in his judgment may be best calculated for the protection of property and the extinguishing of fires; enforce all ordinances and rules and regulations of the Department; report annually to the Village Board all fires occurring in the Village, the origin thereof, if possible, together with the amounts and value of property destroyed and the amount of insurance, if any.

5.05 FIRE PREVENTION


(2) APPOINTMENT OF VILLAGE FIRE CHIEF. The Fire Chief of the City of Baraboo ~~Rural-Volunteer~~ Fire Department shall hold the office of Fire Chief for this Village as long as the Village is under contract to receive fire protection services from ~~is a member of~~ the City of Baraboo ~~Volunteer Rural~~ Fire Department.

(3) ~~RURAL-FIRE CHIEF TO BE FIRE INSPECTOR.~~ The Fire Chief ~~of the Baraboo Rural Fire Department~~ shall hold the office of Fire Inspector with power to appoint one or more Deputy Fire Inspectors, who shall perform the same duties and shall have the same powers as the Fire Inspector.

3. This ordinance shall take effect pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 66.0101(5).

4. The Village Clerk is directed to make the publications and filings required by Wis. Stat. § 66.0101(3).


