The Common Council of the City of Wausau do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Territory Annexed. In accordance with Chapter 66, Wisconsin Statutes, and the petition for direct annexation signed by Diane M. Dahlke-Myers, constituting 100 percent of the owners of, and Gary Nowicki, Tracey Nowicki, and Patrick Breihan, constituting 100 percent of the electors residing within the land now located in the Town of Maine, Marathon County, Wisconsin, and being a part of the Wausau School District, the following described land is hereby annexed to the City of Wausau:

Part of the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 and part the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4, Section 15, Township 29 North, Range 7 East, Town of Maine, Marathon County, Wisconsin, described as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the Southerly line of Lot 1, Overlook Heights, said Section 15, and the Westerly right-of-way of Merrill Avenue, the point of beginning;

Thence Southeasterly, along said Westerly right-of-way, 169 feet to the Northerly line of Certified Survey Map No. 1382 recorded in the office of Register of Deeds for Marathon County in Volume 6 of Certified Survey Maps on page 63; thence Southwesterly, along said Northerly line, 230.93 feet to the Easterly line of Lot 5, said Overlook Heights; thence Northwesterly, along said Easterly line, 169 feet to said Southerly line of Lot 1; thence Northeasterly, along said Southerly line, 230.60 feet to said Westerly right-of-way of Merrill Avenue, the point of beginning.

Section 2. Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of publication of this ordinance, the territory described in Section 1 shall be a part of the City of Wausau and remain a part of the Wausau School District for any and all purposes provided by law, and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the City of Wausau, and governing the

<u>Section 3</u>. <u>Zoning Classifications</u>. Zoning of the within real estate shall be pursuant to Section 23.04.020, <u>Zoning of Annexed Lands</u>, of the Wausau Municipal Code.

<u>Section 4. Aldermanic District.</u> The territory described in Section 1 of this ordinance is hereby made a part of the 7th Aldermanic District and the 17th Ward of the City of Wausau, subject to the ordinances, rules and regulations of the city, county, and state, governing districts.

<u>Section 5</u>. The State of Wisconsin, Department of Administration, has favorably reviewed the annexation and found it not to be against the public interest.

Section 7. Agreement to Pay Town Taxes. The City shall pay to the Town of Maine all necessary property taxes that are due and owing pursuant to the provisions of Section 66.0221(3) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 8. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance, which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

Section 9. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
