AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE VILLAGE OF COMBINED LOCKS, OUTAGAMIE COUNTY, WISCONSIN, PURSUANT TO SECTION 66.0217(2) WISCONSIN STATUTES, THROUGH DIRECT ANNEXATION (UNANIMOUS CONSENT).

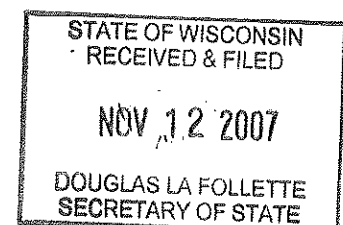
THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF COMBINED LOCKS, OUTAGAMIE COUNTY, WISCONSIN DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) It is resolved and ordered in accordance with Section 66.0217(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes, that the below described property, which is presently in the Town of Buchanan, Outagamie County, is annexed to the Village of Combined Locks, Outagamie County, Wisconsin:

Lot 9 in the Sherwood Forest Subdivision, identified as parcel #03-0-0926-00 in the assessment roll of the Town of Buchanan, and Lot 10 in the Sherwood Forest Subdivision, identified as parcel #03-0-0927-00 in the assessment roll of the Town of Buchanan; and all of the Nottingham Road right-of-way abutting said parcels; all of said lands being part of Sherwood Forest, a subdivision being a part of Government Lot 5, Section 25, Township 21 North, Range 18 East, Town of Buchanan, Outagamie County, Wisconsin.

A scale map is attached hereto, showing the boundaries of the above described territory. The current population of said territory is three (3).

- (2) Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of this ordinance and filing same with the Wisconsin Secretary of State, the territory described in section (1) shall be part of the Village of Combined Locks, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, for any and all purposes provided by law.







(3) Zoning and Ward. The lands that are annexed are to be zoned Residential Single Family. All annexed lands are to become part of Ward #2.

(4) The State of Wisconsin, Municipal Boundary Review, has reviewed the proposed annexation and found it not to be against the public interest.
