

ORDINANCE NO. 267



An Ordinance Annexing Territory to the Village of Lomira, Dodge County,

WHEREAS, a Petition for Direction Annexation of certain territory from the Town of Lomira to the Village of Lomira was filed with the Village of Lomira on June 14, 2010, and

WHEREAS, notice of receipt of this Petition was given to the Clerk of the Town of Lomira pursuant to Wis. Stats. Section 66.0217, and

WHEREAS, a report on the proposed annexation was received by the Village of Lomira from the Wisconsin Department of Administration advising that the proposed annexation was not against the public interest, and

WHEREAS, the Village Board of the Village of Lomira concurs with the conclusions reached in the Department of Administration report, and has concluded that the proposed annexation is reasonable and in the public interest.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Lomira, Dodge County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

SECTION I. The following described territory in the Town of Lomira, Dodge County, Wisconsin, is annexed to the Village of Lomira, Dodge County, Wisconsin:

Part of the SE ¼ of the NE ¼ Section 22, T.13N., R.17E, Town of Lomira, Dodge County, Wisconsin, being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Northeast Corner of said Section 22, T.13N., R.17E.; thence N.88°59' 11"W., along the North line of the NE 1/4 said Section 22, 769.53 feet to the extension of the Easterly right of way line of Pleasant Hill Ave; thence S.0°28'54"E. along said right of way line, 1313.88 feet to the North line of the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of said Section 22; thence S.88°56'26"E. along said North line, 105.46 feet to the Southwest corner of Lot 2 Certified Survey May No. 6151 and the Point of Beginning; thence continuing S.88°56'26"E.along said North line and the South line of Lot 2 Certified Survey No. 6151, 54.95 feet to the Southeast corner of Certified Survey Map No. 6151 and the Westerly right of way of the Soo Line Railroad; thence 54.51 feet along the arc of a curve to the left, along said westerly right of way line, said curve having a radius of 2655.16 feet and a chord which bears S.04°45'03"W. 54.51 feet; thence N.89°03'40"W. 36.75 feet; thence 56.44 feet along the arc of a curve to the right, said curve having a radius of 580.00 feet and a chord which bears N.14°02'01"W. 56.42 feet to the Point of Beginning.

Said parcel contains 0.058 acres or 2,516 square feet more or less.



SECTION II. EFFECT OF ANNEXATION. From and after the date of this ordinance, the territory described in Section I shall be part of the Village of Lomira for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules, and regulations governing the Village of Lomira.

SECTION III. ZONING CLASSIFICATION. The territory annexed to the Village of Lomira by this ordinance shall have a Temporary Town of Lomira zoning classification and attach to Ward 2 of the Village.

SECTION IV. NOTICES. The Village Clerk is directed to file documents required to be filed by Wis. Stats. Section 66.0217(9) with the recipients indicated therein.

SECTION V. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and publishing.
