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CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 9

A CHARTER ORDINANCE TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE VILLAGE FROM THE VILLAGE OF SILVER LAKE TO THE VILLAGE OF SALEM LAKES

WHEREAS, the Village of Silver Lake is a party to a cooperative plan with the Town of Salem, Kenosha County, Wisconsin adopted pursuant to the provisions of section 66.0307 of the Wisconsin Statutes which provides for a change in the boundary between the Village of Silver Lake and the Town of Salem such that the entirety of the territory of the Town of Salem has been included within the jurisdictional boundaries of the Village of Silver Lake; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms and provisions of the cooperative plan between the Town of Salem and the Village of Silver Lake, the Village has agreed to adopt a charter ordinance changing the name of the Village from the Village of Silver Lake to the Village of Salem Lakes;

The Village Board of the Village of Silver Lake, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: The name of the Village of Silver Lake, as set forth in the August 27, 1926 order of the court incorporating the Village, is changed to the Village of Salem Lakes.

SECTION 2: This is a charter ordinance and shall take effect sixty days (60) days after its passage and publication, unless within such sixty (60) days a referendum petition shall be filed as provided by subsection (5) of section 66.01 of the Wisconsin Statutes, in which event this ordinance shall not take effect until submitted to a referendum and approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

SECTION 3: The Village Clerk-Treasurer shall cause this charter ordinance to be published as a class 1 notice, under chapter 985 of the Wisconsin Statutes, and shall file a certified copy of this charter ordinance with the secretary of state.
