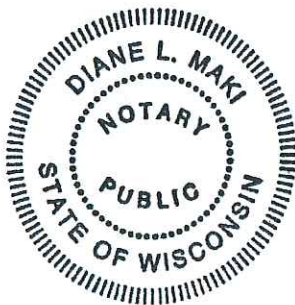

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 10

A CHARTER ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF SALEM LAKES TO REPEAL CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 4 AND NO. 7 TO SEPARATE THE OFFICES OF VILLAGE CLERK AND VILLAGE TREASURER AND PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF BOTH OFFICERS

WHEREAS, on October 21, 1986 the Village adopted Charter Ordinance No. 4 combining the offices of Village Clerk and Village Treasurer pursuant to the provisions of sections 61.195 and 66.01, Wis. Stats. (now 61.0101); and

WHEREAS, on April 5, 2000 the Village adopted Charter Ordinance No. 7 providing for the appointment of the Village Clerk-Treasurer by the Village Board; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms and provisions of the cooperative plan between the Village and the Town of Salem the entire territory and population of the former Town of Salem was added to the Village effective February 14, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the increase in population and territory has significantly impacted the duties and responsibilities of the Clerk-Treasurer such that the Village Board has determined that those duties and responsibilities can be most efficiently performed by a clerk and a treasurer rather than by a single individual.

The Village Board of the Village of Salem Lakes, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: Repeal of Prior Ordinances. Charter Ordinance No. 4 combining the offices of Village Clerk and Village Treasurer and Charter Ordinance No. 7 regarding appointment of the combined office of Village Clerk-Treasurer are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2: Appointment of Officers. Following the effective date of this charter ordinance, the Village Board, by a majority vote of its members, shall appoint a Village Clerk and a Village Treasurer to serve a term commencing upon appointment and ending April 30, 2018 pursuant to section 61.197(1)(c), Wis. Stats. Thereafter, the Village Board, by a majority vote of its members, shall annually appoint a Village Clerk and Village Treasurer for a term commencing May 1 and ending April 30 pursuant to section 61.197(1)(c), Wis. Stats.

SECTION 3: Duties. The respective duties of the Village Clerk and the Village Treasurer shall be those required by statute or ordinance or direction of the Village Board.

SECTION 4: Salary. The Village Board shall set the salary for the Village Clerk and the Village Treasurer giving consideration to the required duties and the experience and skill of the persons appointed.

SECTION 5: Effective Date. This is a charter ordinance and shall take effect sixty days (60) days after its passage and publication, unless within such sixty (60) days a referendum petition shall be filed as provided by subsection (5) of section 66.0101 of the Wisconsin Statutes, in which event this ordinance shall not take effect until submitted to a referendum and approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

SECTION 6: Publication. The Village Clerk-Treasurer shall cause this charter ordinance to be published as a class 1 notice, under chapter 985 of the Wisconsin Statutes, and shall file a certified copy of this charter ordinance with the secretary of state.
