## ORDINANCE NO. #47-2017

# AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AND RECREATE SECTION 1.07 (A) AND 1.07(B) OF APPENDIX A OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF SUMMIT, RELATED TO ORGANIZATION OF THE VILLAGE OF SUMMIT

Whereas, on June 15, 2010, a referendum was held in which a majority of electors in the Town of Summit, located in Waukesha County, Wisconsin, voted in favor of the town incorporating as a Village; and,

Whereas, on July 29, 2010, the Wisconsin Secretary of State issued a Certificate of Incorporation legally establishing and recognizing Summit's status as the Village of Summit; and

Whereas, on July 29, 2010, the interim Village Board of the Village of Summit did adopt Ordinance 1-2010, Charter Ordinance of the Village of Summit, which included the listing, appointment procedures and duties of Appointed Officials for the Village, and

Whereas, the Village of Summit Village Board, has determined that it is in the best interest of the Village to combine the offices of Village Clerk and Village Treasurer;


Now, therefore, pursuant to Section 66.0101 Wisconsin Statutes, and other applicable laws, the Village Board of the Village of Summit, Waukesha County, Wisconsin does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 1-2010, Section 2. Organization of the Village of Summit, Sections 1.07 (A) titled "Village Clerk" and 1.07 (B) titled "Village Treasurer", of Appendix A – CHARTER ORDINANCES, of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Summit are hereby repealed and recreated as follows:

#### 1.07 APPOINTED OFFICIALS

# A. Village Clerk/Village Treasurer

- 1. Change in selection method. Pursuant to Sections 61.195, 61.197 and 66.0101(4), Wis. Stats., the Village of Summit hereby elects not to be governed by those portions of Sections 61.19, 61.23 and 61.25(2), Wis. Stats., which relate to the selection and tenure of the Village Clerk and Village Treasurer, and which are in conflict with this Section.
- 2. Appointment of Village Clerk/Treasurer. The Village Clerk/Treasurer shall be appointed by the Village President at a regularly scheduled Village Board meeting, subject to confirmation by a majority vote of the members of the Village Board. Appointments shall be in writing and made for a fixed term not to exceed three (3) years, subject to removal as provided by law.
- 3. <u>Duties of the Village Clerk/Treasurer</u>. The Village Clerk/Treasurer shall perform the statutory duties of the Village Clerk as outlined in Section 61.25, Wis. Stats., and the Village Treasurer as outlined in Section 61.26, Wis. Stats, and such other duties as



described in the job description adopted by the Village Board and amended from time to time.

## SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY.

The several sections of this charter ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific Section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, Sections or portions thereof of the charter ordinance. The remainder of the charter ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this charter ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This charter ordinance shall take effect 60 days following its passage and publication as provided by Section 66.0101(5), Wisconsin Statutes.
