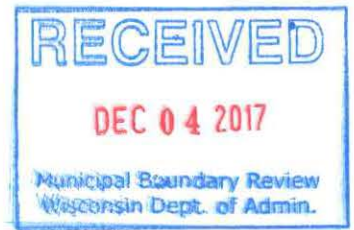

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 1

A CHARTER ORDINANCE CHANGING THE METHOD OF SELECTION OF THE OFFICES OF THE VILLAGE CLERK AND VILLAGE TREASURER FROM ELECTIVE TO APPOINTIVE.

The Village Board of the Village of Marquette, in session duly begun on this 12 day of November, 2017, does ordain as follows

Section One: The Village of Marquette, pursuant to Sections 61.195, 61.197 and 66.0101 of the Wisconsin Statutes, makes an election not to be bound by that part of Wisconsin Statutes 61.19 providing for the election of the Village Clerk and Village Treasurer.

Section Two: In lieu of the statutory requirement of the election of the Village Clerk and Village Treasurer, the offices of the Village Clerk and Village Treasurer shall be by appointment of the Village Board for such terms and for such compensation as shall be determined by the Village Board.


Section Three: The presently elected Village Clerk and Village Treasurer shall continue to hold office until April 30, 2018.

Section Four: The Village Board of Marquette recognizes and declares that this ordinance constitutes a Charter Ordinance and shall not take effect until sixty (60) days after its passage and publication, subject to the provisions of Section 66.0101 of the Wisconsin Statutes.


