

ORDINANCE 1166

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF LAKE MILLS, JEFFERSON COUNTY, WISCONSIN

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKE MILLS, JEFFERSON COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Territory Annexed. In accordance with § 66.0217, Wisconsin Statutes, and the attached and incorporated by reference petition for direct annexation filed with the City Clerk on April 27, 2016, signed by the owners and electors of the properties proposed to be annexed, and the legal description therefor which was amended on May 11, 2016, and July 18, 2016, the following territory in the Town of Lake Mills, Jefferson County, Wisconsin, is annexed to the City of Lake Mills, Jefferson County, Wisconsin.

Section 2. Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of this ordinance, the territory described in Section 1 and as shown in the amended legal description and map, dated May 11, 2016, and July 18, 2016, shall be part of the City of Lake Mills, Jefferson County, Wisconsin, for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules, and regulations governing the City of Lake Mills.

<u>Section 3. Ward Designation</u>. The territory described in Section 1 of this ordinance is hereby made a part of the First Ward of the City of Lake Mills, subject to the ordinances, rules and regulations of the City of Lake Mills governing wards.

<u>Section 4. Severability</u>. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision of application.

<u>Section 5. Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.




