ORDINANCE #18-04

AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF JACKSON

THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF JACKSON, WASHINGTON COUNTY, WISCONSIN, does hereby ordain the following changes to the Village Code:

SECTION I. Amending Chapter 2 – Article IX. – Elections – of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Jackson, Wisconsin, to add Ward 11.

Sec. 2-466 WARDS AND POLLING PLACE.

Ward 11: Ward 11 has an approximate voter total of 0 (zero) and was attached by Ordinance #18-03 on June 12, 2018. Ward 11 is comprised of: State Senate District 20, State Assembly District 60, Washington County Supervisory District 14, Germantown School District, and Milwaukee Area Technical College District. Ward 11 is detailed in Exhibit A.



ORDINANCE #18-03

AN ORDINANCE ATTACHING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE VILLAGE OF JACKSON

WHEREAS, the Village of Jackson and the Town of Jackson are parties to a Mediated Cooperative Plan Agreement (hereinafter, the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the Agreement was approved by the Wisconsin Department of Administration on June 8, 2018; and

WHEREAS, under the terms of the Agreement, immediately upon the Department of Administration's approval, the Village is to attach certain Town territory known as "Paloroma Farms," which is further described on the attached Exhibit A, to the Village; and

WHEREAS, under the terms of the Agreement, the attachment of Paloroma Farms is to occur through the adoption of an attachment ordinance under Wis. Stat. § 66.0307(10); and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance is intended to serve as that attachment ordinance:

NOW, THEREFORE, THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF JACKSON, WASHINGTON COUNTY, WISCONSIN, pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Agreement, together with the powers conferred pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 66.0307, does hereby ordain as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** The lands set forth in <u>Exhibit A</u>, commonly known as Paloroma Farms, are hereby attached to the Village effective immediately.
- **SECTION 2.** The Village Clerk is directed to file the documents required by Wis. Stat. § 66.0307(10) and to take all other necessary action to implement this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its posting or publication as required by law.


