

Section 66.0217 (6), Wis. 

Subject: FOND DU LAC COUNTY ANNEXATION

The proposed annexation submitted to our office on July 31, 2017, has been reviewed and found to be in the public interest. In determining whether an annexation is in the public interest, s. 66.0217 (6), Wis. Stats. requires the Department to examine "[t]he shape of the proposed annexation and the homogeneity of the territory with the annexing village or city...." so as, to ensure the resulting boundaries are rational and compact. The statute also requires the Department to consider whether the annexing city or village can provide needed municipal services to the territory. The subject petition is for territory that is reasonably shaped and contiguous to the **CITY OF FOND DU LAC**, which is able to provide needed municipal services.
