#### **BARRON COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 2013 -41**



### Resolution to Amend Supervisory District – City of Rice Lake Due to Annexation

### TO THE BARRON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

- 1 2 WHEREAS, based on federal and state laws, municipalities are required to recreate 3 voting districts based on current census figures and compiled each decade; and 4 5 WHEREAS, Barron County completed this process by Resolution No. 2011-15 and 6 Resolution No. 2011-31; and 7 8 WHEREAS, Section 59.10(3)(c), Wis. Stats., provides that: "1. After the enactment of 9 a plan of supervisory districts under par. (b), the board may amend the plan to reflect a 10 municipal incorporation, annexation, detachment or consolidation. The number of supervisory 11 districts in the County shall not be changed by any action under this subdivision."; and 12 13 WHEREAS, the City of Rice Lake has annexed a parcel of property as identified in the 14 attached map, ordinance annexing, and further described as: 15 16 A parcel of land located in that part of the SW ¼ of the NE ¼, and part of the NW ¼ of 17 the SE ¼, all in Section 8, T35N, R11W, Barron County, Wisconsin, more particularly 18 described as follows: 19 20 Commencing at the North Quarter of said Section 8; Thence S00°02'09"E, along the North/South 21 quarter line of Section 8, 2658.29 feet to a point on the North right-of-way line of 22 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> Avenue, and the 22 Point of Beginning; Thence S88°27'01"E along the North right-of-way line of 22 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> Avenue, 1312.32 23 feet; Thence S00°09'57"E along the East line of the NW ¼ - SE ¼, 1337.88 feet to the Southeast corner 24 of said NE ¼ - SE ¼; Thence N88°36'22"W, along the South line of said NE ¼ - SE 1/4 : 1315.26 feet 25 to the Southwest corner of said NW 1/4 - SE 1/4; Thence N00°02'09"W, along the West line of the NW 1/4 26 - SE ¼, 1341.36 feet to the point of beginning; 27 28 Along with land being that part of Lot 1, Certified Survey Map No. 5157, Volume 35, 29 Page 130, located in the Northeast ¼ of the Southwest ¼, that part of the Northeast ¼ 30 of the Southwest <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, and that part of the Southeast <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the Southwest <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, all in Section 31 8, Town 35 North, Range 11 West, Barron County, Wisconsin more particularly 32 described as follows: 33 34 Commencing at the Northeast corner of the said Southwest <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> also being the point of beginning; Thence 35 westerly along the northerly line of the said Southwest <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> to a point which is 33 feet west of at a right 36 angle to the East line of the said Southwest 1/4; Thence southerly 33 feet from and parallel to the east 37 line of the said Southwest 1/4 to the south line of the said Southwest 1/4; Thence easterly along said southerly line to the Southeast corner of the said Southwest 1/4; Thence northerly along the easterly 38
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beginning.

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- 42 WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Executive Committee that the 43 Supervisory District Plan adopted by Resolution No. 2011-31 be amended to transfer the

boundary of said Southwest 1/4; to the northeast corner of said Southwest 1/4 also being the point of

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above-described parcel from Supervisory District 25 and include in Supervisory District 22;and

WHEREAS, this resolution was approved by the Executive Committee on October 2,
2013, on a vote of 8 - 0, with Bartlett, Heinecke, Horstman, Miller, McRoberts, Mosentine,
Rogstad and Thompson voting in favor and no members voting against. Jost was absent.

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50 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Barron County Board of 51 Supervisors does amend the County Supervisory District Plan adopted by Resolution 2011-15 52 and Resolution 2011-31 to transfer the above-described parcel from Supervisory District 25 in 53 the City of Rice Lake and include it in Supervisory District 22 in the City of Rice Lake.
