

BARRON COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 2014 - 45

**Resolution to Amend Supervisory District – Village of Prairie Farm
Due to Annexation**

TO THE BARRON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

1
2 **WHEREAS**, based on federal and state laws, municipalities are required to
3 recreate voting districts based on current census figures and compiled each decade; and
4

5 **WHEREAS**, Barron County completed this process by Resolution No. 2011-15
6 and Resolution No. 2011-31; and
7

8 **WHEREAS**, Section 59.10(3)(c), Wis. Stats., provides that: “1.After the
9 enactment of a plan of supervisory districts under par. (b), the board may amend the plan
10 to reflect a municipal incorporation, annexation, detachment or consolidation. The
11 number of supervisory districts in the County shall not be changed by any action under
12 this subdivision.”; and

14 **WHEREAS**, the Village of Prairie Farm has annexed a parcel of property as
15 identified in the attached map, ordinance annexing, and further described as:
16

17 That part of the Southeast Quarter (SE ¼) of the Southwest Quarter (SW ¼) of
18 Section Twenty-Eight (28), Township Thirty-Two (32) North, Range Thirteen
19 (13) West, Town of Prairie Farm, described in Volume 135, Page 541 of Deeds
20 in the Barron County Register of Deeds, except for that part conveyed for
21 highway purposes described in Volume 409, Page 872 of Deeds in the Barron
22 County Register of Deeds.

24 **WHEREAS**, it is the recommendation of the Executive Committee that the
25 Supervisory District Plan adopted by Resolution No. 2011-31 be amended to transfer the
26 above-described parcel from Supervisory District 7 and include in Supervisory District 6;
27 and

28 **WHEREAS**, this resolution was approved by the Executive Committee on
29 December 3, 2014 on a vote of 9 - 0, with Okey, Henck, McRoberts, Miller, Bartlett,
30 Thompson, Heinecke, Horstman, Rindsig (alternate for Christensen) voting in favor and
31 no members voting against.





32 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Barron County Board of
33 Supervisors does amend the County Supervisory District Plan adopted by Resolution
34 2011-15 and Resolution 2011-31 to transfer the above-described parcel from Supervisory
35 District 7 in the Town of Prairie Farm and include it in Supervisory District 6 in the
36 Village of Prairie Farm.
