Resolution to Amend Supervisory District due to  
Detachment from the City of Chetek into the Town of Prairie Lake

TO THE BARRON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

1  
2       **WHEREAS**, based on federal and state laws, municipalities are required to recreate  
3 voting districts based on current census figures and compiled each decade; and  
4

5       **WHEREAS**, Barron County completed this process by Resolutions 2011-15 and 2011-  
6 31, and further amended the supervisory districts by Resolutions 2013-41, 2013-42, 2014-45,  
7 2018-25, 2019-3 and 2019-21; and  
8

9       **WHEREAS**, Section 59.10(3)(c), Wis. Stats., provides that: “1.After the enactment of  
10 a plan of supervisory districts under par. (b), the board may amend the plan to reflect a municipal  
11 incorporation, annexation, detachment or consolidation. The number of supervisory districts in  
12 the County shall not be changed by any action under this subdivision.”; and  
13

14       **WHEREAS**, the Town of Prairie Lake has accepted/annexed 2 parcels of property that  
15 were detached from the City of Chetek as identified in the attached map, ordinances  
16 accepting/annexing and detaching, and further described as:  
17

18       Parcel ID #211-8044-22-000 (now 036-2500-26-000) and 211-8044-23-000 (now 036-2500-27-000)  
19

20       Lot 1 and Lot 2, both of Certified Survey Map No. 6448, Volume 43, Page 28, Document No. 843381,  
21 being part of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 25, Township 33 North, Range 11 West.

23       All in Barron County, Wisconsin.

25       **WHEREAS**, it is the recommendation of the Executive Committee that the  
26 Supervisory District Plan adopted by Resolutions 2011-15 and 2011-31, as amended by  
27 Resolutions 2013-41, 2013-42, 2014-45, 2018-25, 2019-3 and 2019-21 be amended to transfer  
28 the above-described parcels from Supervisory District 1 to 4; and  
29

30       **WHEREAS**, this resolution was approved by the Executive Committee on January 8, 2020, on  
31 a vote of 9 - 0, with Okey, Bartlett, Heinecke, Buchanan, Horstman, Thompson, Nelson  
32 (alternate), Heller (alternate) and Hanson voting in favor and no members voting against.  
33 Rindsig and McRoberts were absent.  
34

35       **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Barron County Board of  
36 Supervisors does amend the County Supervisory District Plan adopted by Resolutions 2011-15  
37 and 2011-31, as amended by Resolutions 2013-41, 2013-42, 2014-45, 2018-25, 2019-3, and  
38 2019-21 to transfer Parcels #036-2500-26-000 and 036-2500-27-000 from Supervisory District  
39 1 to Supervisory District 4 in the Town of Prairie Lake.

41       **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that publication of this resolution may occur through  
42 posting in accordance with Section 985.02 of the Wisconsin Statutes.


