Please find enclosed a copy of the redistricting plan for Polk County which officially goes into effect for the April 2022 election. You will find the Resolution along with a copy of the map.

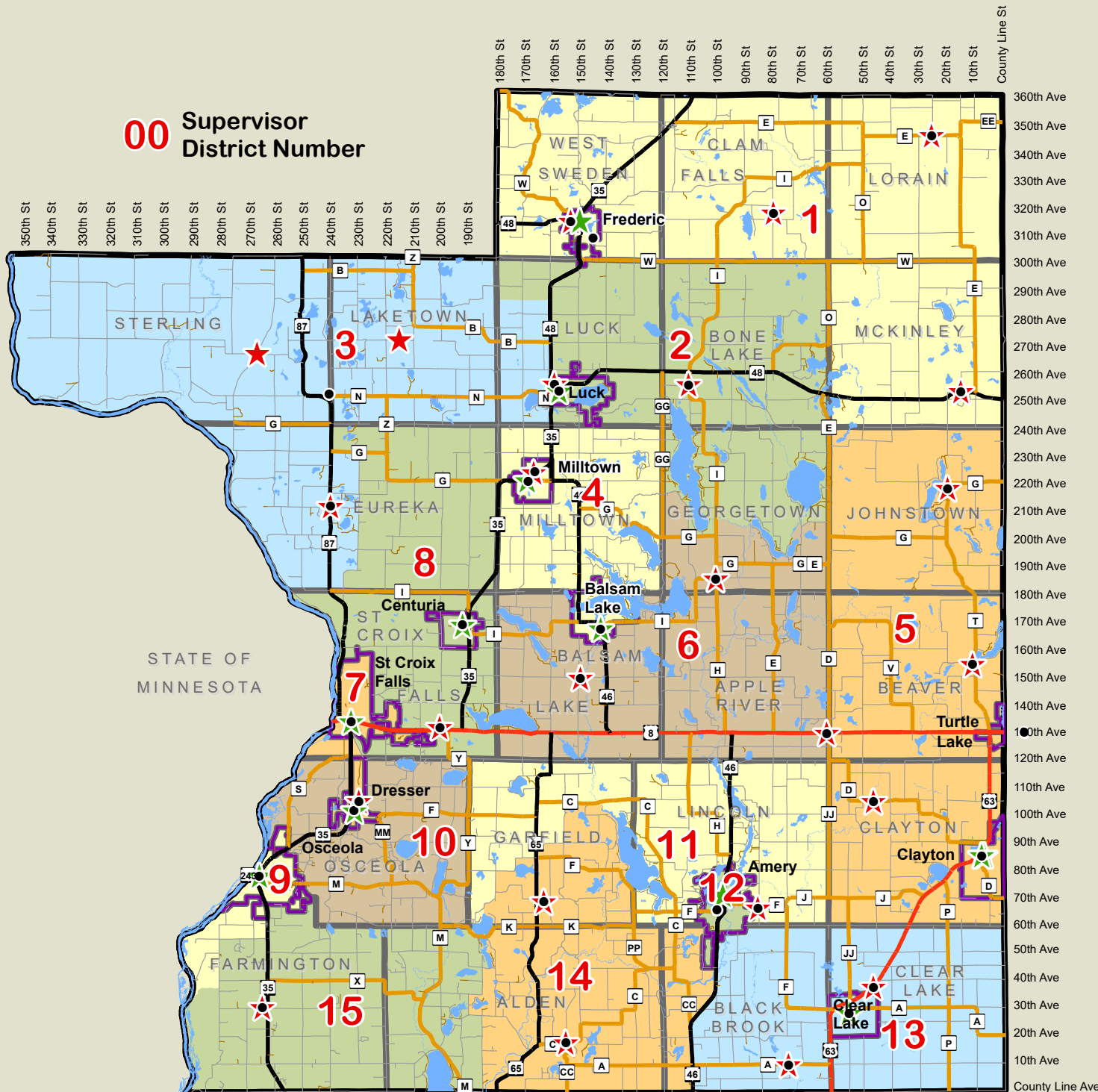
This new plan will remain in effect until such time at the next census, when redistricting will once again take place. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact our office.

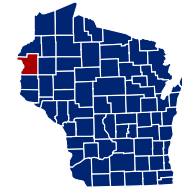

RESOLUTION TO ADOPT FINAL COUNTY SUPERVISORY DISTRICT PLAN

TO THE POLK COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

WHEREAS, every ten years the United States Census Bureau conducts a census of the population and provides population counts to local municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin delivered detailed population data and block-level maps to Polk County in August 2021; and

WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin Statutes §59.10(3)(b)1., the Polk County Board of Supervisors conducted a public hearing on the tentative supervisory district plan on September 21st 2021, then adopted and transmitted the tentative supervisory district plan to each municipal governing body in Polk County; and

WHEREAS, each municipality of Polk County has reviewed said temporary supervisory district plan and adjusted its wards as required by Wisconsin Statute §5.15; and

WHEREAS, State of Wisconsin Statutes §59.10(3)(b)2., requires counties to hold a public hearing and the adopt a final county supervisory district plan;

WHEREAS, the Polk County Board of Supervisors has received said proposed supervisory district plan, and on November 9, 2021, has conducted a public hearing on the proposed final county supervisory district plan for the purpose of receiving public commentary on said proposed plan; and

WHEREAS, the proposed final county supervisory district plan contains supervisory districts which meet the requirements under §59.10(3)(b)2., with regard to contiguity and compactness, and to the extent possible, place whole contiguous municipalities or contiguous parts of the same municipality within the same district; and

WHEREAS, the proposed final county supervisory district plan conforms with §59.10(3)(b) 1)(b)1. and 2., and (3)(c)1., in that the number of districts equals the number of supervisors; the districts are substantially equal in population according to the most recent countywide federal census; the districts are in as compact a form as possible; and the districts consist of contiguous municipalities or contiguous whole wards that exist at the present time; and

WHEREAS, the proposed final county supervisory district plan accomplishes the goals of redistricting because said plan affords as much as possible populations of such districts the opportunity to elect representatives who share their community, backgrounds and interests; gives deference to existing ward lines; minimizes political confusion that may exist; and gives recognition to those areas which have a sustained trend of growth in population; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Polk County Board of Supervisors adopts the final county supervisory district plan, attached to and incorporated herein this resolution and shall first apply to election of supervisors to the Polk County Board of Supervisors to be held in April 2022.

55 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes
56 §59.10(3)(b)4., the Chair of the Board of Supervisors file a certified copy of the
57 final county supervisory district plan with the Secretary of State.
